ORDER ON DEFENDANT STEVEN DORFMAN'S EMERGENCY MOTION TO MODIFY ASSET FREEZE TO PAY REASONABLE LIVING EXPENSES AND ATTORNEYS' FEES

This cause came before the Court upon Defendant Steven Dorfman's Emergency Motion to Modify Asset Freeze Order to Pay Reasonable Living Expenses and Attorneys' Fees (the "Motion") [ECF No. 41]. The Court has reviewed the Motion and the record, heard argument of counsel at the hearing on December 6, 2018, and is otherwise fully advised. Based thereon, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

- 1. The Motion is **GRANTED** in part;
- 2. The Receiver shall release \$75,000 of the frozen personal assets to Mr. Dorfman's counsel for attorneys' fees. Any additional requests for payment of attorneys' fees shall be accompanied by detailed timesheets reflecting the work done on the matter; and

3. The Receiver shall pay Mr. Dorfman \$5,000 per month for reasonable living expenses from the frozen personal assets.
